All students must have completed 45 quarter / 30 semester credits of prerequisites at a regionally accredited institution prior to enrolling in the OHSU nursing program; 30 quarter/20 semester prerequisite credits must be completed by the end of fall term of the student's application year. The 30 quarter prerequisite credits must include completion of one term of Anatomy & Physiology and Intermediate Algebra/Math 95 or higher. Some students will meet these requirements by the end of their second fall term, while others may need to attend longer to meet minimums for application. All prerequisite courses must be taken for a grade of "C-" or higher and must be undergraduate level. If a student has taken a course multiple times, OHSU will use the most recent grade. All-natural science coursework (Anatomy & Physiology series, Microbiology, and Nutrition) must be taken within 7 years from the intended start year (Ex: 2014-2021 for 2021).
